BARCELONA

WALKING TOUR OF BARCELONA Thursday, April 18th, 9 a.m.

Today we'll join our guide for a 3-hour walking tour of Barcelona to enjoy all the key sites.

MONTSERRAT TOUR Friday, April 19th, 9 a.m.

We'll enjoy touring the city with a bus and guide plus we'll be offering some great optional day trips including <u>Montserrat</u>, just an hour's drive northwest of Barcelona. Montserrat is both a magnificent and breathtaking mountain range and a place of recollection. A major symbol of Catalan culture. Several types of visits can therefore lead you there. The <u>Montserrat Monastery</u>, its Abbey, the Moreneta - the black Madonna - and the Escalonia. There's also a cable car that can take us to the highest peak of the mountain range and also the possibility of wine tasting at a local winery.

FULL DAY TOUR Saturday, April 20th, 9 a.m

Another optional tour from Barcelona is a day trip to <u>Girona</u> <u>and Costa Brava</u>. Girona is an easy and worthy day trip from Barcelona. A delightful city badly damaged by French troops in 1809 but which nowadays boasts many interesting sights including the Passeig Arqueologic (Archaeological Walk), a pleasant walkway along the old ramparts of the city. See the Iglesia de Sant Feliu, dating from the 14th century as well as the 15th



century cathedral, which has some Catalan Baroque style but is mainly gothic. The Jewish quarter is very interesting to explore and the city boats many fine restaurants, bars and shops. Much of the city's charm comes from its narrow medieval streets-with frequent stairways, as required by the steep terrain.

Palace, Bishop's Palace, Courtyards, Church of Santa Eulalia and church of Saint Francis, Town Hall square, Parliament, and so on. If you want to enter the Cathedral the admission is 6 euro. This tour is included in your package.

FULL DAY MALLORCA TOUR Tuesday, April 23rd



Today we will be with Magdalena again for this full day bus tour of the island. First, we will go to the picturesque village of Valldemossa which lies in a beautiful valley between the mountains of **Serra de Tramuntana**. Tourism provides the main source of income for the people of Valldemossa. Visitors are enchanted with the town's

steep, narrow little streets, the house-fronts adorned with flower-pots and tiles that tell the tale of the life of Blessed Catalina Thomàs.

Another noteworthy building is La Cartuja and Royal Palace. The little town of Valldemossa won universal fame thanks to the arrival of Chopin, George Sand and her children (1838-1839) to sojourn in the Carthusian Monastery.

We will also visit of the Monastery of La Cartuja (where the pianist Frederic

Chopin lived in 1838-39) and visit King Sancho's Palace (ancient palace dating of the 14th century) and enjoy a concert in the Palace (15min). We will have some free time to stroll around.

From there we will make our way across the beautiful mountains of the West of Majorca, visiting Soller town and tram ride to its port (port Soller). The tram ride is very picturesque as it was built in 1913.

<u>COST</u>: with bus, guide, tram tickets and monastery admission is \$44.



The other option for today would be for you to rent a scooter to see the island but previous experience is highly recommended.

SEVILLE

WALKING TOUR Thursday, April 25th, 9:00 am This tour is included in your package.

Today we will do a part bus and part walking tour of Sevilla. We'll see the Alcazar and Cathedral from the outside, we will walk in Santa Cruz, the old Jewish Quarter, see the river with the Tower of Gold and Square of Spain. This tour that will give us a general view of the old Seville.



MORROCCO Friday, April 26th, 6:00 am

The guide will meet the clients and departure towards Tarifa, the nearest point between Europe and Africa, only 14 kilometres away.

6 a.m. depart hotel. Our bus trip to the harbor will take 2 hours.

9.00 AM - After crossing the Spanish border, embark on a fast ferry that takes 35 minutes to reach Africa.

9.45 AM - On arrival the local guide will be waiting at the harbour and begin with a



panoramic tour of the city by motorcoach. We will cross differents quarters of Tangiers, stop for photos and camel rides (camel ride costs around 1 Euro) and then head back downtown, going on a walking tour to the Kasbah (walled city), the medina (old city) and the souks.

Finally we will stop for restrooms and lunch at a typical restaurant to enjoy the arab food (harira soup, cous-cous, brochete, moroccan tea and pattisserie).

2.15 PM - Before taking the ferry back you will visit a moroccan bazaar where bargaining over prices is part of the shopping culture.

3.00 PM - Return to the harbour, crossing back over the Strait of Gibraltar and on arrival to Tarifa, we will return to "La Costa del Sol".

INCLUDES:

- Transport by private coach from Torremolinos
- Fast ferry tickets Tarifa Tangier Tarifa (35 minutes).
- Private transportation for the visit.
- Local guide for the visit.
- Moroccan lunch in a local restaurant (vegetarian meals are available).

PASSPORT CONTROL:

On the ferry, you must seek the police desk where passports are stamped for entry

into Morocco. This is very important because if you do not have your passport stamped, they will not let you off of the fast ferry into Morocco.

TIPS:

Beware of drinking tap water and using ice; this has caused gastroenteritis in the past.

Always ask for price before buying, especially in bars and restaurants. Please do not allow the waiter to bring you food without previously asking for it and knowing how much it is going to cost you.

Bargaining: it is mandatory and necessary. Divide the initial price by 4 to start the game. Always let the seller give the final price. Don't be surprised if a seller asks for a very expensive price at first; they do this to provoke you. With good negotiating skills, you can get a good price.

Tips are usually not included in the final price; ten percent tips are usually given, and \in 0.50 per suitcase.

In restaurants, alcohol is very expensive, so we recommend drinking bottled water and/or soft drinks.

Always ask before taking someone's picture.

Never ask questions like, "when will we go back to Spain?", or "where we are going?"; in general, do not give out any information whatsoever about where you are from or details of this program.

RONDA, MARBELLA and PUERTO BANUS Saturday, April 27th, 9:00 am



On this full day trip, we will head inland to Ronda. Arriving in Ronda, we'll see all the highlights of this lovely town, which is one of the oldest in **Spain** dating back to prehistoric times. We will do a walking tour of the **town** starting from the town square, known as **Plaza de Espana**. we will finally end up at the Plaza de **Toros**

Maestranza and it's museum, one of the oldest Bull Rings in Spain.

The picturesque town of Ronda spans the plunging river gorge known as El Tajo,

crossed by the impressive 18th-century **Puente Nuevo** bridge.. We'll have free time to explore **Ronda** and perhaps enjoy lunch at a local restaurant (not included) before heading to Marbella and Puerto Banus.
